## FREE

## COLD

Players will show up in the standings, have access to some basic statistics, save money when entering ACL events and will not pay deposit fees into the ACL Wallet!

## PLATINUM

Players will show up in the standings, have access to detailed statistics, receive a discount on the ACL Digital Network (ACLDN), get Early Bird registration access for Open events and World Championships and will pay no deposit or withdrawal fees!

ACL Divisions are intended to group players of similar skill levels together for competitive $\mathscr{E}$ social play. It is important that players read, review and establish their Skill Level. This enables a player to know where they stand and compete against players of similar skill level. Conference/Regional Directors may override a Skill Level if they feel a player playing in a skill level that is too low or too high.

The current ACL Divisions and Skill Rating Levels include:

ACL PRO DIVISION/ SKILL LEVEL
ACL Pro means that you have achieved the highest skill level in the sport and have accepted the terms laid out by the ACL to become an ACL Pro. ACL Pro players must play in the Open division at Open, Conference and Regional events. (PPR Range: > 9) - PPR stands for Points Per Round which is a players average points per round during game play.

OPEN DIVISION
The "Open Division" which as the name implies is Open to anyone from Pro level players down to Novice level players (similar to how the Advanced division was in the past). This is NOT a skill level, rather it's a division that allows directors to combine Pros and Advanced players and will offer maximum points towards player rankings. *Note that at World, Open, Conference and Regional events the director may require players to play in their skill level tournaments. Thus an Intermediate player may not be allowed to play in an Open/Advanced/Competitive tournament (directors discretion).

ADVANCED DIVISION/ SKILL LEVEL
The Advanced Division will NOT allow Pro's to play in the division at Open, Conference and Regional events. However, not all areas will offer both an Open Division and an Advanced division. In those areas there will simply be an Open division and no Advanced division. There can certainly be top level players in the Advanced Skill Level who have not yet earned/accepted the ACL Pro Player Title. This player can execute sliding the bag and airmailing the bag as needed. Player fully understands game strategy and likely plays and practices on a regular basis. (PPR Range: > 8.3)

COMPETITIVE DIVISION/ SKILL LEVEL
The Competitive Division is intended for players who are good, but not quite ready for the Advanced level. For areas that have a lot of depth at the top end of players, it makes sense for a Director to offer Open/Advanced and Competitive Divisions for Local, Regional and Conference tournaments. This player fully understands game strategy, but may struggle with consistency. At times this player looks like they can beat anyone, but then in a subsequent game or round can struggle. (PPR Range: 7.3-8.3)

INTERMEDIATE DIVISION/ SKILL LEVEL
The Intermediate Division is for players that enjoy playing casually but are competitive enough to beat the Novice level players. Players can enjoy the sport and events without having to play the top players.This player has a feel for the distance needed to toss the bag, but can be erratic in getting the bag to consistently be in the middle of the board. This level of player is working on developing a consistent pitch. (PPR Range: 6.4-7.3)

NOVICE DIVISION/ SKILL LEVEL
The Novice Division is intended for beginners and large events that have a lot of Intermediate players.This player has limited experience with the game and usually has very little control over where the bag is going. (PPR Range: < 6.4)

## ACL BAGS POLLCY

Bring Your Own Bags (BYOB) - The ACL believes that players should be able to have a choice when it comes to bags. The ACL has set guidelines and created a list of Approved Bag Manufacturers.
Players are required to use properly stamped bags from this list for all ACL points events. If a player does not have bags on the list we ask for the Director to provide that player with an approved set. 2023-2024 ACL Bags Policy

## ACL BGG CHHLLENGES

Should bags be challenged at an ACL event the director will only measure bag thickness and check bag weight for any bag with an ACL stamp PRIOR to 2023. If a bag has an ACL stamp of 2023 or after the director will also check bag size.

## ACL TOUNUAMENTS

NEW all points tables have been updated this season.*Importantl A player must pay and play in at least one game in the tournament in order to earn ACL points. This is true for all levels (Local, Regional, Conference, Open, Pro). Also, any event that has more than 64 entries must be split into two (or more) brackets. Each bracket will play for points independent of the other bracket(s).

## LOCAL TOURNAMENTS

Local points tournaments can apply to ANY singles, BYOP doubles or blind draw doubles tournament. If you are playing in a tournament that does not include ACL Points, ask your Director why?!? Points are awarded based on where a player/team finishes in the tournament. ACL Open Standings will take a player's Top 15 Local Tournament Finishes and use them towards their ACL Rankings. In order for a local tournament to be counted for ACL points you must have 6 players (for singles) and 6 teams (for doubles). If you do not have 6 singles or 6 doubles then that tournament will NOT count for ACL points.

- A Regional Director may run one Monthly Regional Points Tournament for each Division (Open, Advanced, Competitive, Intermediate, Novice) and by Tournament Type (Singles, BYOP, Blind Draw) per month.
- Each Regional Director must offer a minimum of three Divisions (Open, Competitive and Intermediate) and include at least two tournaments for each (one singles and one blind draw or bring your own partner doubles).
- The maximum number of Monthly Regional events a Regional Director can run is 10 ( $10 / 01 / 2023$ - 07/21/2024)
- Tournaments may be run on different days. Example: 1st Tuesday of every month is Regional Singles. 2nd Tuesday of every month is BYOP doubles. 3rd Tuesday of every month is Blind Draw Doubles, etc...
- In order for a Monthly Regional tournament to be worth Regional points you must have 6 players (for singles) and 6 teams (for doubles). If you do not have 6 singles or 6 doubles then that tournament will NOT count for ACL points.
- Monthly Regionals MUST be seeded starting no later than November.
- All directors MUST offer a minimum $\$ 10$ discount for Gold, Platinum and Diamond ACL Members at Regional, Conference and Open events.
- Payouts will vary based on Regional Director.
- Players may play in more than one Monthly Regional Event in a Month, but only the top score for singles and top score for doubles/blind draw will count as their Monthly Regional Score for that month.
- ACL Open Standings will include your Top 6 Monthly Regional Singles + Top 6 Monthly Regional Doubles (Blind Draw or BYOP) scores for Points Rankings.

## CONFERENCE [2] \& STATE CHAMPIONSHIP [1] TOURNAMENTS

Again this year will be a State Championship event for each state. Therefore in 2023-2024 there will be two Conference events per Conference AND one State Championship per State. The State Championship events will count for Conference points.

The Top 100 players in each conference will be invited to the Conference Championship event and Conference Pro Qualifier which will be held in August or September 2024. More details on those events later in this document.

ACL Open Standings will include Top 2 Conference/State Singles + Top 2 Conference/State Doubles (Blind Draw or BYOP) finishes.

- ACL Conferences are formed at the discretion of the ACL.
- Each Conference will hold 2 Conference Events and 1 State Championship per State throughout the 2023/2024 season. Conference/State Event dates MUST be approved by the ACL National Directors. We do not want Conference Events to be run the same weekend as ACL Open Events in the same geographical area.
- The 2 or 3 Day Conference/State events MUST offer Open, Advanced, Competitive and Intermediate (Singles, BYOP, Blind Draw). As well as Women's, Senior and Junior singles.
- Conference and State Events MUST be seeded.
- Players may only play in their assigned Conference events and the State Championships of the State they live in. Players who are located close to conference lines and who would like to compete in a conference other than their assigned conference MUST compete in a majority of their regional events within the desired conference. A player cannot change conferences after 2/28/2024.

## OPEN TOURNAMENTS

- Each player may play in as many Open tournaments as they wish.
- There will be a MINIMUM of 16 ACL Open Tournaments during the season.
- Open tournaments are a minimum 2-Day event and include Open Doubles and Singles based on skill levels as well as Women's Singles, Senior Singles and Junior Singles.
- Doubles will be $\$ 120 /$ team and Singles will be $\$ 60 /$ player. Each team will play a minimum of 6 doubles games using the ACL Rounders format. After ACL Rounders is over all players are split into 3 levels for doubles. Each level thencompetes in a double elimination doubles bracket. Level 1 is the top level and will earn the most points and earn the most prize money. All players will play no less than 8 doubles games!
- Doubles will be a 60\%+ payout. $80 \%$ for tier 1, 15\% for tier 2 and 5\% for tier 3.
- Singles will be $\$ 60 /$ player. All players MUST play in the skill level shown on their player profile. The only exception is Advanced level players can choose to play in the Open Division with the Pro's or the Advanced division with no Pro's. All singles entry fees are then added up and 60\% of the entry fees are split across the divisions with Open winning the most, Advanced 2nd most, etc...
- Event MAY also include a Pro Shootout Qualifying event.
- ACL Open Standings will include your Top 2 Open Singles + Top 2 Open Doubles scores.
- All Open Winners in Open Singles and Level 1 Doubles will be invited to play in the "ACL Open Tournament of Champions" event at the 2024 ACL World Championships. Open singles winners will play in the $\$ 5,000$ winner take all single elimination singles championships and Open Level 1 doubles winners will play in the $\$ 5,000$ winner take all single elimination doubles championships.If a player wins doubles with different partners, they will play in this event with their first open winning partner.

Anyone finishing in the top 100 in their Conference will be invited to participate in their Conference Championship event. This event will be held in August/September 2024. The event will include: Free jerseys/shirts to anyone who qualifies for the event, the right to play in single and doubles, the right to play in the Conference Pro Qualifier where the winner will earn the right to be a Pro for the 2024-2025 season.


Go to iplaycornhole.com and click on Login in the upper right hand corner.

On the next screen login to your ACL account. If you do not have an ACL account you can click on "Join ACL" and create a new ACL account (it's free!)

Once logged in click on "Dekaround" \& then click on "Start Dekaround Tracker"

Now you are ready to play! After you throw your first round you enter how many bags you made in the hole and how many were on the board, then click the right arrow to move to the next round. After you've played 10 rounds you can click on "Save Game" and your game will save. You can then look at your average Dekaround score and history of your Dekaround in the ACL system!

- ACL will have separate standings for each of the following: Pro Singles, Pro Doubles and ACL Open Standings.

- ACL Open Standings is a Combination of:

Conference Points (Best 2 Conf/State Singles Events, Best 2 Conf/State Doubles Events) + Top 4 Open Points (Best 2 Open Singles Event, Best 2 Open Doubles Event).
- Points are used for seeding and to determine Pro eligibility.
- Conference Standings this year will include local (top 15), regional (top 6 singles and top 6 doubles) and conference/state (top 2 singles and top 2 doubles). NEW Open events will NOT count in the Conference standings.
- State Standings only include local (top 15) and regional (top 6 singles $\mathbb{A}$ top 6 doubles) events along with the State Championship event (singles and doubles).
- Women's Singles Standings (more details on the next page, \$25,000 Guaranteed in Prize money!)
- Senior Singles Standings (more details on page 13, \$25,000 Guaranteed in Prize money!)
- Junior Singles Standings - USA Cornhole Juniors Qualifications.
- Players can also check the Player Detail tab to see how their standings are generated from individual tournaments.
