DIVISIONS & SKILL LEVELS

ACL Divisions are intended to group players of similar skill levels together for competitive and social play. It is important that players read, review and establish their Skill Level. This enables a player to know where they stand and compete against players of similar skill level. Conference/Regional Directors may override a Skill Level if they feel a player playing in a skill level that is too low or too high. The current ACL Divisions and Skill Rating Levels include:

ACL PRO DIVISION

ACL Pro means that you have achieved the highest skill level in the sport and have accepted the terms laid out by the ACL to become an ACL Pro. ACL Pro players must play in the Open division at Open, Conference and Regional events. (PPR Range: > 9) - PPR stands for Points Per Round which is a player's average points per round during game play

ELITE DIVISION

ACL Elite players are amateur players who have the opportunity to compete against ACL Pro players at the highest level. To become an ACL Elite player for the 2024-2025 season, you must first obtain an Advanced skill level as designated in your ACL Player Profile and then register as a Diamond ACL Member. Once that is complete, you will have the opportunity to sign an ACL Elite contract, allowing you to compete as an ACL Elite player. OPEN DIVISION

The "Open Division" which as the name implies is Open to anyone from Pro level players down to Novice level players. This is NOT a skill level, rather it's a division that allows directors to combine Pros, Elite and Advanced players and will offer maximum points towards player rankings. *Note that at World, Open, Conference and Regional events the director may require players to play in their skill level tournaments. Thus an Intermediate player may not be allowed to play in an Open/Advanced/Competitive tournament (directors discretion).

ADVANCED DIVISION

The Advanced Division will NOT allow Pro's to play in the division at Open, Conference and Regional events. However, not all areas will offer both an Open Division and an Advanced division. In those areas there will simply be an Open division and no Advanced division. There can certainly be top level players in the Advanced Skill Level who have not yet earned/accepted the ACL Pro Player Title. This player can execute sliding the bag and airmailing the bag as needed. Player fully understands game strategy and likely plays and practices on a regular basis. (PPR Range: > 8.3; Canada > 7.8)

COMPETITIVE DIVISION

The Competitive Division is intended for players who are good, but not quite ready for the Advanced level. For areas that have a lot of depth at the top end of players, it makes sense for a Director to offer Open/Advanced and Competitive Divisions for Local, Regional and Conference tournaments. This player fully understands game strategy, but may struggle with consistency. At times this player looks like they can beat anyone, but then in a subsequent game or round can struggle. (PPR Range: 7.4 - 8.3; Canada: 6.9 - 7.8)

INTERMEDIATE DIVISION

The Intermediate Division is for players that enjoy playing casually but are competitive enough to beat the Novice level players. Players can enjoy the sport and events without having to play the top players. This player has a feel for the distance needed to toss the bag, but can be erratic in getting the bag to consistently be in the middle of the board. This level of player is working on developing a consistent pitch. (PPR Range: 6.6 - 7.4; Canada: 5.9 - 6.9)

NOVICE DIVISION

The Novice Division is intended for beginners and large events that have a lot of Intermediate players. This player has limited experience with the game and usually has very little control over where the bag is going. (PPR Range: < 6.6; Canada: < 5.9)

PLAYER ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM

The American Cornhole League is excited to introduce an innovative Player Engagement Program designed to reward dedication & enthusiasm within our vibrant community of cornhole enthusiasts. This program centers around a Points System, where players earn points at every tournament they participate in, regardless of the outcome. This initiative aims to encourage more active participation, foster a sense of community, & enhance the competitive spirit of the league.

HOW IT WORKS:

1. Earning Points

Participation Points: Every player who registers & competes in an ACL-sanctioned tournament will earn points. The more tournaments a player participates in, the more points they accumulate.

Point Allocation: Points are awarded based on participation, with a standardized system ensuring fairness across all levels of play. For example, players will earn 1 point for each Local Club tournament, 2 points for each Regional tournament, 3 points for each State tournament, and 4 points for each Open tournament.

2. Tracking

Player Profiles: Each player can view their accumulated points in the ACL Player app.

3. Incentives & Rewards

Milestone Rewards: Players can unlock special rewards at various point milestones, such as exclusive ACL merchandise, access to special events, or recognition by ACL Pros.

4. Engagement & Community Building

Leaderboards: Regularly updated leaderboards showcase the top point earners, creating a competitive yet friendly environment where players can celebrate their achievements and strive to improve.

5. Program Benefits

Increased Participation: By rewarding participation rather than just victories, the program encourages more frequent engagement and a higher level of commitment from players.

Enhanced Experience: The Points System adds an extra layer of excitement and motivation, enhancing the overall tournament experience for players at all levels.

Community Growth: The program fosters a strong sense of community and camaraderie among players, creating a more connected and supportive cornhole environment.

ACL BAGS POLICY

The ACL believes that players should be able to have a choice when it comes to bags. The ACL has set guidelines and created a list of Approved Bag Manufacturers. Players are required to use properly stamped bags from this list for all ACL points events. If a player does not have bags on the list we ask for the Director to provide that player with an approved set.

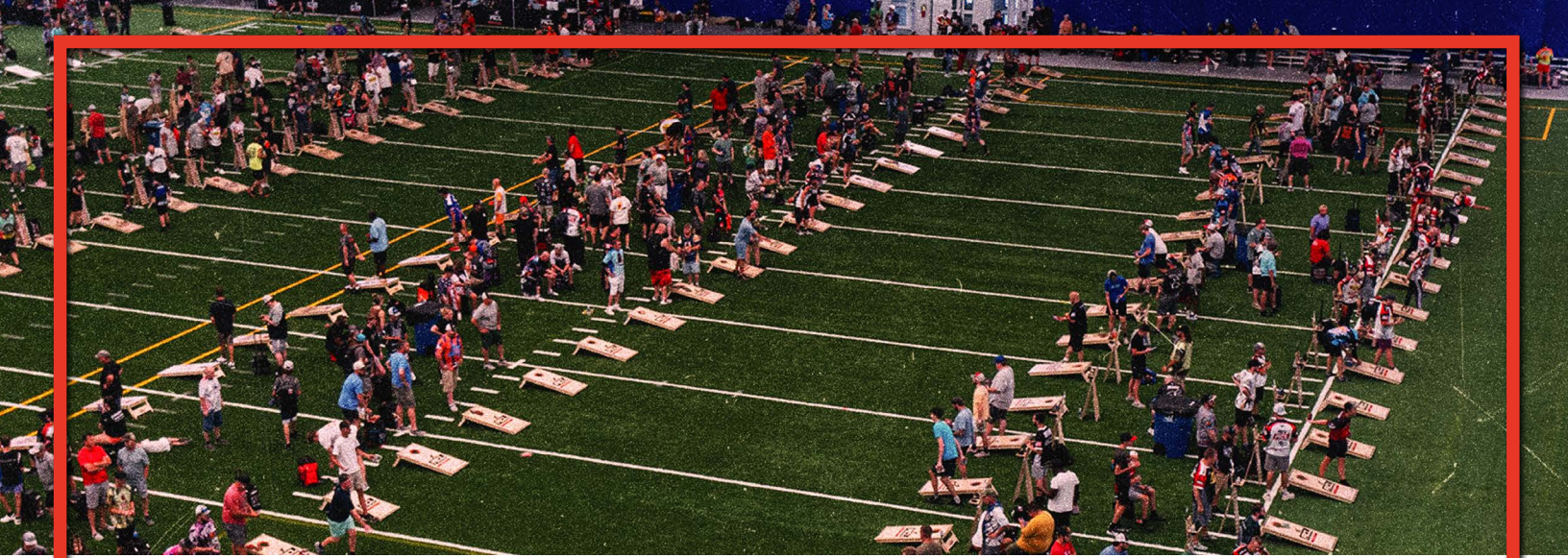

ACL TOURNAMENTS

***IMPORTANT!** A player must pay and play in at least one game in the tournament in order to earn ACL points. This is true for all levels (Local, Regional, State, Open, Pro). Also, any event that has more than 64 entries must be split into two (or more) brackets. Each bracket will play for points independent of the other bracket(s).

ACL CLUBS

For the 2024-2025 season, the ACL is unveiling its new ACL Club model, designed to enhance the experience for both players and directors. Under this model, players have the flexibility to compete in events hosted by any paid director, with their performance and rankings being prominently visible. Directors, on the other hand, will gain the capability to showcase club rankings through detailed points and various statistical metrics derived from the events they manage. This initiative aims to provide greater transparency and foster a more competitive environment within clubs participating in the ACL community.



ACL TOURNAMENTS

LOCAL TOURNAMENTS

- Local points tournaments can apply to ANY singles, doubles or blind draw tournament. If you are playing in a tournament that does not include ACL Points, ask your Director why?!? Points are awarded based on where a player/team finishes in the tournament.
- ACL State Standings will take a player's Top 24 Local Tournament Finishes and use them towards their ACL Rankings.
- In order for a local tournament to be counted for ACL points you must have 6 players (for singles) and 6 teams (for doubles). If you do not have 6 singles or 6 doubles then that tournament will NOT count for ACL points.
- Players earn 1 Player Engagement Point for every ACL Local points tournament they participate in.

MONTHLY REGIONAL TOURNAMENTS 10 MAX PER REGION

- A Regional Director may run one Monthly Regional Points Tournament for each Division (Open, Advanced, Competitive, Intermediate, Novice) and by Tournament Type (Singles, BYOP, Blind Draw) per month.
- Each Regional Director must offer a minimum of three Divisions (Open, Competitive and Intermediate) and include at least two tournaments for each (one singles and one blind draw or bring your own partner doubles).
- The maximum number of Monthly Regional events a Regional Director can run is 10 (10/01/2023 – 07/21/2024)
- Tournaments may be run on different days. Example: 1st Tuesday of every month is Regional Singles. 2nd Tuesday of every month is BYOP doubles. 3rd Tuesday of every month is Blind Draw Doubles, etc...
- In order for a Monthly Regional tournament to be worth Regional points you must have 6 players (for singles) and 6 teams (for doubles). If you do not have 6 singles or 6 doubles then that tournament will NOT count for ACL points.
- Monthly Regionals MUST be seeded starting no later than November.
- All directors MUST offer a minimum \$10 discount for Gold, Platinum and Diamond ACL Members at Regional, State and Open events.
- Payouts will vary based on Regional Director.
- Players may play in more than one Monthly Regional Event in a Month, but only the top score for singles and top score for doubles/blind draw will count as their Monthly Regional Score for that month.
- ACL Open Standings will include your Top 6 Monthly Regional Singles + Top 6 Monthly Regional Doubles (Blind Draw or BYOP) scores for Points Rankings.

OPEN TOURNAMENTS 16 MINIMUM

- Each player may play in as many Open tournaments as they wish.
- There will be a MINIMUM of 16 ACL Open Tournaments during the season.
- Open tournaments are a minimum 2-Day event and include Open Doubles and Singles based on skill levels as well as Women's Singles, Senior Singles and Junior Singles.
- New this season Pro and Elite players will have their own specific division for both singles and doubles.
- All Amateur players will play the same format as in the past for doubles. All teams will play 4-6 games of rounders to determine Tier 1, Tier 2 and Tier 3 and then participate in a double elimination tournament within those Tiers.
- In singles all Amateur players will start directly in Tier 1 (Open), Tier 2 (Competitive) or Tier 3 (Intermediate) singles. All players MUST play in the skill level shown on their player profile for singles.
- Entry fees increase two weeks prior to each Open tournament.
- The Pro/Elite division along with Tier 1 in singles and doubles will play for cash prizes awarded via the ACL Wallet. Tier 2 and Tier 3 in singles and doubles will play for ACL prizes.
- Players earn 4 Player Engagement Points for every ACL Open points tournament they participate in.
- Points earned in Tier 1, 2 and 3 at ACL Open events will count towards your state ranking.
 - Points earned in Tier 1, 2 and 3 use the Regional Points table and count for regional points that month.
 - Example: A player participates in doubles at a regional tournament and earns 94 points in October '24. He/she also plays in an ACL Open tournament in October and in doubles he/she earned 96 points. Therefore he/she earns 96 regional points for the month of October.

STATE/PROVINCE TOURNAMENTS

This season there will be two State tournaments held in each state, but we will no longer offer Conference tournaments going forward.

- The 2 or 3 Day State events MUST offer Open, Advanced, Competitive and Intermediate (Singles, BYOP, Blind Draw) tournaments.
Women's, Senior and Junior singles are no longer required, but are encouraged to be held at State tournaments.
- State Events MUST be seeded by State Points
- There will be two types of State events each season
 - Interstate Tournaments
 - Open to all players
 - Players may play in as many Interstate Tournaments as they like
 - State Championships
 - Players must play in the State where they live for the State Championship event
- ACL State Standings will include a players Top 1 State Singles + Top 1 State Doubles (Blind Draw or BYOP) finishes.
- Players earn 3 Player Engagement Points for every ACL State points tournament they participate in.

CANADIAN OPEN TOURNAMENTS

- Each player may play in as many Open tournaments as they wish.
- There will be a MINIMUM of 4 ACL Canada Open Tournaments and an ACL Canada National Championships during the season.
- Open tournaments are a minimum 2-Day event and include Open Doubles and Singles based on skill levels as well as Women's Singles, Senior Singles and Junior Singles.
- All players will play the same format as in the past for doubles. All teams will play 4-6 games of rounders to determine Tier 1, Tier 2 and Tier 3 and then participate in a double elimination tournament within those Tiers.
- In singles all players will start directly in Tier 1 (Open), Tier 2 (Advanced), Tier 3 (Competitive) or Tier 4 (Intermediate) singles. All players MUST play in the skill level shown on their player profile for singles.
- ACL Canada Pro division will have a Singles, Doubles and Team event at each of the Opens and National Championships.
- Entry fees increase two weeks prior to each Open tournament.

ACL STANDINGS

Details on Pro Standings including Pro Singles, Pro Doubles, Women's Pro Singles, Women's Pro Doubles, Senior Pro Singles, Senior Pro Doubles, Junior Pro Singles and Junior Pro Doubles can be found in the ACL Pro Guide.

ACL STATE STANDINGS ARE A COMBINATION OF:

- Top 24 Local Tournament Points + Top 12 Regional Points (Best 6 Regional Singles Events, Best six Regional Doubles Events) + Top 1 State Points (Best 1 State Singles Events, Best 1 State Doubles Events).
- ACL Club Standings are kept at the director level where the director can choose which events (local and regional) count towards their Club Standings.
- Players can also check the Player Detail tab to see how their standings are generated from individual tournaments.
- Ties for seeding will be randomly broken.
- The last day to earn ACL points will be 7/20/2025.
- New this season, the Top 5 Pro/Elite players in each state points standings will play in their own Pro Qualifier at the ACL World Championships with the top 6 players becoming ACL Pros the following season (6 additional players). 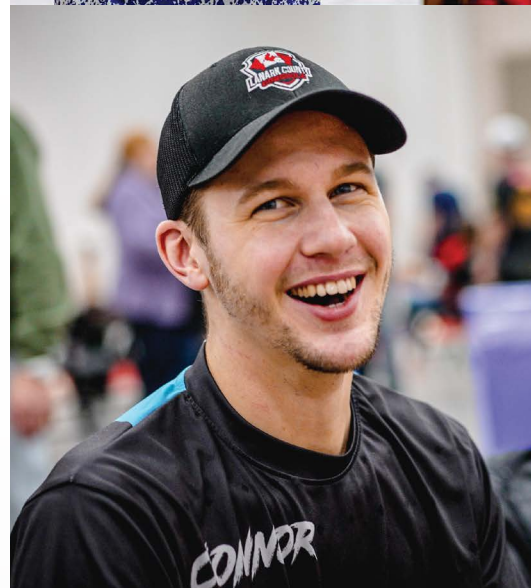

ACL CANADA STANDINGS:

- ACL Provincial Standings are a Combination of:
- Top 12 Local Tournament Points + Top 12 Regional Points (Best 6 Regional Singles Events, Best 6 Regional Doubles Events) + Top 1 Provincial Points (Best 1 Provincial Singles Events, Best 1 Provincial Doubles Events) + Top 1 Open Points (Best 1 Open Singles Events, Best 1 Open Doubles Events).
- ACL Club Standings are kept at the director level where the director can choose which events (local and regional) count towards their Club Standings.
- Players can also check the Player Detail tab to see how their standings are generated from individual tournaments.
- Ties for seeding will be randomly broken.
- The last day to earn ACL points will be 7/20/2025

All remaining spots for the ACL World Championships will be offered to ACL Diamond and Platinum members first, then everyone else if open spots remain.
